*An Important Reminder From Your Wilton Manors  
Police Department Code Compliance Unit*

As we all know Hurricane Season is June 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup> of each calendar year. We are asking for the community's help to make sure that everyone is safe this year if a hurricane strikes our area. We all saw first hand, the devastation that Hurricane Wilma caused. Listed below are a few code sections that we ask you please abide by:

**Sec. 13-26. Prohibition of litter, untended vegetation, weeds, grass, hard junk and sanitary nuisances**

**13-26(b)** The owners, resident, tenant, or other person having possession or being in charge of or occupying any real property within the city shall keep such property and the adjoining portions of the public right-of-way, swales and canal banks clean and free from any sanitary nuisance. The following conditions existing, permitted, maintained, kept, or caused shall constitute prima facie evidence of maintaining a sanitary nuisance.

**13-26(c)** The owners, resident, tenant, or other person having possession or being in charge of or occupying any real property within the city shall keep such property, and the adjoining unpaved portions of the public right-of-way, swales and canal banks clean, and free from any accumulation of garbage, litter or trash.

**13-26(e)** The owners, resident, tenant or other person having possession or being in charge of or occupying any real property within the city shall not permit hard junk to be stored, maintained or otherwise kept on any real property in the city. Any such person is required to provide for the removal of any hard junk within three (3) working days following receipt of notice by the city in accordance with this section.

*\*These code sections simply state that any type of furniture, branches, storage of bulk items, trash/debris, garbage, litter, etc. should be removed from your property immediately\**
